Primary Purpose of the job

Counselling within a systems framework to children, young people, couples and families utilising strengths based, solution focussed, system and relationally centred therapy.

About (The Network / Program) The REPAIR program is a demonstration project delivered through a partnership between The Salvation Army Crossroads Network and The Salvation Army Westcare.

The REPAIR program will provide children and young people who have experienced the trauma of family violence with a range of individual and group delivered therapeutic interventions, tailored to their individual recovery needs.

Based in Melbourne's North and North West, the program focus is on those children and young people who are:

- in continuing/leaving care
- first timers in out of home care
- accompanying women in family violence refuges

A project team of four staff will deliver the REPAIR program in collaboration with a range of specialist therapists who will be engaged on an as needs basis. The REPAIR team has a target of providing tailored individual therapeutic plans for 80 young people over a 12 month period, each with a minimum three months engagement in the program. The REPAIR team will work closely with the young person's case manager to optimise engagement with therapies and monitor progress with individual therapeutic plans.

Expected Outcomes

- Provide quality support and therapeutic service to children, young people and their families.
- Develop innovative methods of working therapeutically with children, young people and their families including individual therapy, couple therapy, family therapy and group work.
- Participate in the intake of new clients.

Scope

The Family Therapist is part of a small team of four dedicated staff that includes two family violence specialists or 'navigators' and a Team Leader. The program has an overall target of 80 young people participating in the program over a 12 month period, each with an individual therapy plan. The role will provide a mix of individual Family Therapy sessions as well as co facilitate group work other team members. The position has no reports.

Qualifications and Experience

- Tertiary qualification in social work, psychology or other related discipline
- Post-graduate qualification and/or training in Family Therapy
- Minimum three to five years' practice experience as a Family Therapist
- Professional expertise Demonstrated experience and expertise in assessment, formulation and counselling interventions with individuals, families and groups, referring appropriately and conducting closures to achieve quality outcomes.
